SCHOOL ZONE REQUIREMENTS

School zones are the established zones between the elementary schools within the school district. These zones have been previously established by the school board and maps showing the zones are available to the public on request.

New students should register for the elementary school located in the zone in which they reside. However, the placement of students in any particular elementary school is subject to the rules and practices ordered by the superintendent (or his/her designee), who may determine that placement in a different elementary school is appropriate based on non-discriminatory factors such as capacity and resources for individual student needs.

Students attending Athens City Schools must re-enroll annually during an advertised reenrollment period. The school zone for elementary students re-enrolling is the school they currently attend. However, elementary students who re-enroll outside the advertised reenrollment period may be placed at a different elementary school pursuant to the rules and practices ordered by the superintendent (or his/her designee), who may determine that placement in a different elementary school is appropriate based on non-discriminatory factors such as capacity and resources for individual student needs.
